
PURPOSE







Glimpses of Case Studies

1. AROGYAM SERIES

Under Arogyam Series (Anemia Mukt Haryana) started in 2016 by SMAS and Health Society, more than 2000 lives have been benefited through health camps. Hb level of 62 people have been substantially improved in adopted Village Lakhuwas in 2022-23.

















2. SOLS conducted a case study on drug trafficking to raise awareness among youth about its dangers and consequences. The study highlights the impact of drugs on individuals, families, and communities. By sharing real-life stories and statistics, SOLS aims to educate and empower young people to make informed choices and avoid involvement in illegal activities.

The data highlighted notable shifts in device usage, social media engagement, academic achievements, and the quality of student-teacher interactions across the two modes of education. One of the key findings of our study was the substantial increase in mobile phone usage among students post2020, reflecting a broader trend towards digitalization in education.




