In 2019-22 course scheme MOOC were introduced with 1 credit in III, IV Semester and 2 Credit for V, VI semester

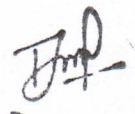

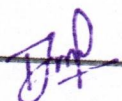

1.05. To approve revision in content of some courses of B.Arch. program to upgrade to latest knowledge and techniques.

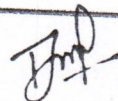

1.13. To approve curriculum of new courses added in BA Fashion Design.

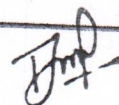

Curricula are attached as Annexure V

9.06. To report non-registration of B.Sc. (Hons.) Mathematics students (Batch 2020-2023) for MOOC and to offer MOOC course on Matrix Analysis with Applications (2 credits) in III year

Students of B.Sc. (H) Mathematics batch 2020-2023, could not be opt MOOC course in III semester as semester commenced late due to pandemic and registration for MOOC was closed for that course so it was proposed that MOOC course on **Matrix Analysis with Applications** (2 credits, MOOC Course available on Swayam) would be offered to students either in Vth semester or VI semester to complete the knowledge of students. A modified course structure is attached herewith having total credits of 152 (Annexure VI).

9.07. To consider and approve the Program Outcome (PO), Program Specific Outcome (PSO), Program Educational Objectives (PEO) and Course Outcome (CO) of B.Sc. (Hons.) Mathematics and M.Sc. Mathematics from 2021 as per OBE pedagogy

Outcome-Based Education (OBE) is a student –centric teaching and learning methodology in which the course delivery and assessments are planned to achieve stated outcomes. **The Program Outcome (PO), Program Educational Objectives (PEO), Program Specific Outcome (PSO) & Course Outcome (CO)** of each course of B.Sc (Hons.) Mathematics and M.Sc Mathematics have been designed which focus on measuring students' performance i.e. outcomes at different levels and ensure that the students are following the exponential progressive learning by means of various teaching tools. The same were approved by the Board of Studies members as per Annexure VII

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9.08. To consider and approve the curricula revision for three courses of M.Sc. Chemistry: BSCH701 (Chemistry of D and F Block Elements) to BSCH707A (Chemistry of D and F-Block Elements and Bioinorganic Chemistry); BSCH702 (Chemistry of Boron, Silicon and Organometallic Compounds) to BSCH708 (Boranes, Silicates and Organometallic Compounds) and BSCH801 (Co-ordination Chemistry) to BSCH807 (Co-ordination Chemistry and Inorganic Polymer Chemistry)

As per feedback from academic experts, revision in curricula of three courses offered in M.Sc. Chemistry were suggested i.e. BSCH701 (Chemistry of D and F Block Elements); BSCH702 (Chemistry of Boron, Silicon and Organometallic Compounds) and BSCH801 (Co-ordination Chemistry). The purpose of revision of these courses was to provide core competency and meet the recent requirements of the course. 6.01. To confirm the minutes of meeting of 5th Board of Studies meeting held on 5th Sep 2019.

The minutes of 5th BOS Meeting were circulated to all the members of the BOS and no comments were received. Members considered and approved the minutes as per annexure-I of the agenda item.

6.02. To report action taken on the decision made in the 5th Board of Studies meeting held on 5th Sep 2019.

The action taken on the decisions made in the 5th Board of Studies were reported and approved as per annexure II.

6.03. To discuss and approve the conduction of online sessional and End Term Examinations for Theory and Practical courses of B. Pharmacy (II, IV, VI, VIII Sem), M. Pharmacy (II, IV Sem), D. Pharm (I and II Year), as per the advisory

issued by PCI (Ref. No. 14-56/2019-PCI(A)), UGC (D.O.No.F.1-1/2020 (Secys)) for the duration of the Covid-19 pandemic.

Khar has suggested that keeping in mind the usefulness of the Disaster Management course, students may be encouraged to study the same, but without eroding the current syllabus prescribed by the PCI. IT may be offered as a Value-Added Course, without any credits.

- 6.06. To discuss and approve the format of syllabi for B.Pharm, M.Pharm, D.Pharm and BPT according to the LOCF (Learning Outcomes based Curriculum Framework) pattern as recommended by UGC.

The restructuring of syllabus, without any changes in the course content, according to LOCF pattern was approved by the board. Prof. Khar and Prof. Siddiqui reiterated the importance of not only changing the format as a requirement, but also understanding and implementing the Learning Outcomes, in order to improve the imparting of education.

The above changes have been approved unanimously and the same may be reported to the academic council for adoption and approval. The syllabi for B. Pharm, M. Pharm, D. Pharm and BPT (Sem I to IV) according to the LOCF pattern are attached as Annexure I.

6.08. To discuss and approve the adoption of the University Pattern for evaluation of all BPT courses from Academic Session 2020-21.

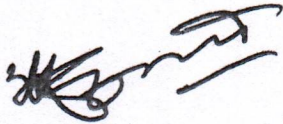

Expert members approved mapping of PEOs, POs, PSOs, and COs for Diploma, Bachelor, Master of Pharmacy and BPT programmes with Outcome Based Education Framework from the academic session 2021-2022 onwards (Annexure III).

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Due to the lockdown and adoption of online mode of teaching, the programme structures of BPT 2019 and BPT 2020 batches were altered.
