



- To make students aware to uplift the quality of the living environment through active planting and afforestation


Content

School of Legal Studies, KRMU in collaboration with Donation Box India Foundation (NGO) organized a plantation drive on Wednesday 31st August 2022 in nearby village Lakhuwas (As shown in Photo 1). In total 48 students from SOLS, Six members from NGO and 5 faculty members went for plantation drive. The students and faculties along with NGO team brought different plants like Jamun, Neem, Amla, Ashoka, Belpatra, Kadamb and Kachnaar with them. The bus reached Lakhuwas Village and all the arrangements were done there. Locals of the village attended the students and other members for drive and guided their way to nearby fields where the saplings and trees could be planted. The students has planted 6 trees of Indian Blackberry (Jamun), Neem, Ashoka, Belpatra, Kadamb and Kachnaar and 10 saplings of different flowers and vegetables (Photo 2). Faculty members, NGO team members and local villagers helped them in plantation by providing them with the tools and other necessities as shown in Photo 3. The Faculty coordinators educated and inspired the students to be more careful and dedicated towards their environment.


Event Outcome:



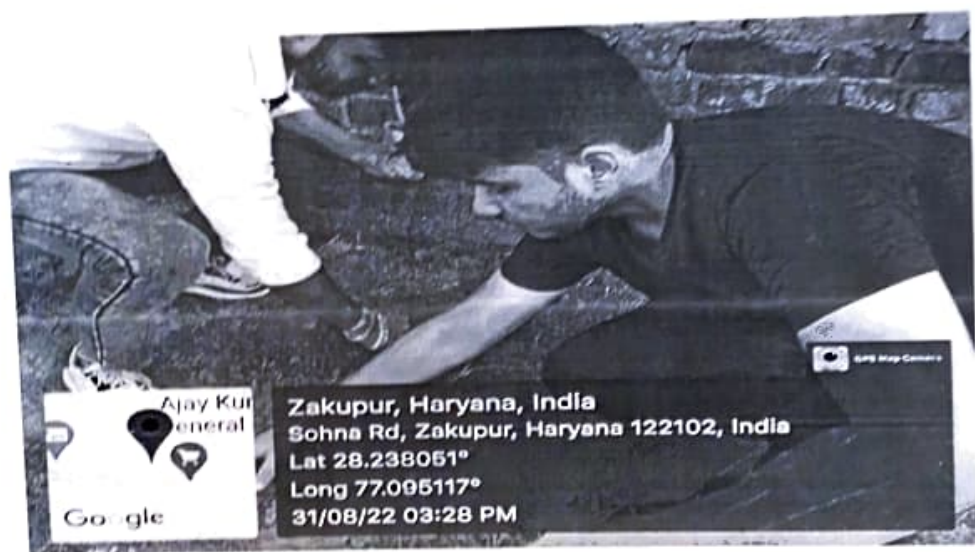

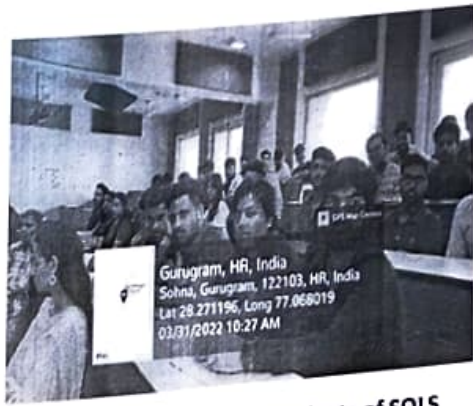
