MEMORANDUM OFUNDERSTANDING

The Memorandum of Understanding is executed on 19th Day of May, 2022

BETWEEN

K.R. Mangalam University, Sohna Road, Gurgaon - 122103 (Delhi NCR Region), a private university established in 201 3 and empowered to award degrees as specified by UGC under section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956, through its Registrar, duly authorized to enter into and sign an MOU on behalf of K.R. Mangalam University (hereinaster referred to as KRMU) PARTY OF THE FIRST PART.

AND

NORMI Research Foundation is a Public Trust registered under Indian Trusts Act, 1882 having its registered office at Flat No. 112, SFS, Munirka Enclave, New Delhi – 110067 and through its National Odour Research and Management Institute (hereinafter referred as 'NORMI') through its Secretary General Dr. Ajay Garg, duly authorized in this regard to sign an MOU on behalf of NORMI, PARTY OF THE SECOND PART.

The expression KRMU and NORMI shall, mean and include the Institutions/Organizations, their successors, appointees, assignees etc.

NOW THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITNESSES:

- 1. That there will be non-exclusive collaboration between the odour and odour related basic and applied science faculties of KRMU and the scientists of NORMI in the areas of joint interests.
- That this collaboration will extend the facilities of the two Institutions/labs for complementing
 joint research projects and to train each other's' students and employees to facilitate the
 overall research, training and Placement.
- 3. That the two Institutions will conduct joint programs including offering courses and training as per mutual interest.
- 4. That wherever there is potential for research funding from national/international agencies, the applications for such funding in areas of mutual interest may be submitted jointly after obtaining permission of the competent authorities of the two Institutions
- 5. That officers / scientists working at NORMI may be recommended for admission to Ph.D. programme of the KRMU. The KRMU may admit such recommended officers I scientists of NORMI provided they meet the Ph.D. admission criteria of KRMU and after following the prescribed admission procedure.

- The admitted students of NORMI will be required to complete course work as per Ph D
 Regulations of KRMU. Course work of specified credits will have to be completed at
 KRMU. The university may conduct such course work at NORMI or on week-ends, if
 there are sufficient numbers of Ph.D. candidates recommended by DRF and admitted by
 KRMU.
- The admitted students of NORMI will be required to choose a supervisor from KRMU and one or more co-supervisor(s) from NORMI who should be a regular scientist of NORMI at the level of Scientist 'E-1' or above, of CSIR cadre or equivalent with a Ph.D. degree and having the requisite experience as per the Ph.D. regulations of KRMU. A list of eligible Scientists, along with CVs and list of publications will be provided by the HR Manager of Salve to obtain a formal approval from the appropriate academic body of KRMU at the time of processing of specific applications from NORMI.
 - Research scholars of NORMI who are admitted to Ph.D. programme will be required to
 pay the requisite fees of KRMU, every semester, till the completion of Ph.D.
- 6. That Ph.D. students working at KRMU will be able to carry out a part of their research work at NORMI and if needed, may take NORMI scientist(s) as co-supervisor(s).
- That KRMU and NORMI will independently cover the cost of research chemicals and other expenditure incurred in connection with the research collaboration.
- That NORMI will extend its facilities and provide short-term training to students and faculty members of the KRMU in their areas of specialization, on the request from KRMU.
- The Scientists/Governing body members/advisors/any other senior person of NORMI may be invited to deliver lectures in specific courses or conduct seminars at KRMU.
- That Mobility of Professors/Faculties of KRMU and Scientists of NORMI between KRMU and NORMI will been encouraged.
- 11. That IPR generated under the joint research program shall be jointly shared by NORMI and KRMU. That if any IPR related issues arise, the same shall be jointly resolved by NORMI and KRMU.
- 12. That the tenure of this MOU is two years from the date of signing of the MOU. This MOU may be amended/ extended for specified duration by mutual consent in writing of both the parties.

- 13. That this MOU may be terminated by either party at any time provided that the terminating institution gives to other party written notice of intention to terminate at least six months prior to termination.
- 14. That a joint committee with two members from each side's hall be constituted to periodically review the progress of this MOU.
- 15. That in the event to if any dispute rising out of this Memorandum of Understanding or in it enforcement the parties to this MOU will resolve the same amicably. However, in case the dispute remains sun resolved, it shall be referred to an independent arbitrator appointed by KRMU/NORMI. The decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding up on the party concerned. The seat of arbitration shall be Delhi.
