- 6. There will be no financial liability on part of either party.
- 7. The scope and duration of the collaboration may be amended and/or extended through the joint agreement further with the consent and approval of both parties.
- 8. This MoU will come into force upon affixing of signatures of the representatives of the partner institutions and will remain in effect for one (1) year.
- 9. This MoU may be renewed upon its expiry, with the agreement of both the partner institutions. If either partner institution wishes to terminate the MoU at the end of one year, it must notify the other institution not less than three months prior to the expiry of the MoU.




