

#### INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL

IQAC carried out several reforms to enhance quality in teaching and learning.

#### a) Curriculum Reforms:

**Project Based Learning**: In continuation with the previous efforts of university to learn concepts by performing experiments through which several students benefitted. In view of Covid -19 pandemic, as the university was closed, and online teaching was going on, students were asked to continue working on projects which were offered across university. They were asked to prepare software, reports etc. based on the projects chosen by them. Experts or renowned governing body members were involved to provide them guidance/mentorship for projects. This enabled them to learn in the faster way and helped them build research acumen.

#### b) ICT Reforms:

i) Development of Online learning platforms: Onset of Covid-19, made faculty and students to adapt new technique of online learning. University was asked to conduct several workshop and training sessions for faculty and students to help them teach and learn through online tools like MS teams, Zoom etc. Exchange of assignments, presentations through LMS became common. Guidelines to faculty were given to accept Predissertation submissions presentation and PhD Viva Voce online. Online virtual tours of industry were also planned. Online examinations were conducted. Even Yoga and Meditation programs were also conducted online for faculty and students.

**ii)**Increase in bandwidth of internet: As online teaching was going on, IQAC provided directives to university to increase bandwidth of internet so that teaching does not hamper.

- **c) School Connect Programs:** As an initiative of IQAC, several school students got registered for various coaching and induction programs which were offered by all schools. Coaching for JEE, CLAT, NEET and other such competitive examinations were provided by faculty.

## OFFICE OF DEAN STUDENT WELFARE

K. R. 
#### 1. Chetna Society



#### 3. Health Society

The club has conducted several events and explored the horizons of creativity, diversity and arts. The club inherently believes that culture can potentially strengthen the individual and society as a whole. Through the conduction of various activities and programmes, the committee has created ample opportunities for the students to develop their creative abilities, indulge in cultural activities and play an important role in preserving and promoting our culture. When the world was fighting with COVID, everyone was at home, undergoing health issues and mental stress, the cultural society organized several events with the intention of bringing joy to their lives. ## **INFRASTRUCTURE**

### **UNIVERSITY HOSTELS**

The University hostels span across ample acres and accommodate all needs of students and faculty members alike. They provide access to all amenities, like sports, gym, healthy meals, and compact living spaces.

#### **Medical Facilities**

- > The Hostel has a medical center which provides general treatment & first aid services.
- ➤ 24X7 ambulance facility.
- The medical services and nursing staff are available 24 X 7.

#### **Physiotherapy Centre**

The University has a full-fledged physiotherapy centre for students.

### **Hostel Discipline**

The hostellers are expected to abide by all hostel rules:

- > Students are not allowed to leave their respective room's after 10:30 pm.
- Any student, who wishes to go out of the hostel, needs to obtain an 'Out-Pass' from their respective wardens after receiving their parents' consent.
- > Students are not allowed to do unethical activities that violate hostel rules and regulations.
- > Strict action is taken in disciplinary act/cases is given as per hostel rules and regulations.
- > Students are encouraged to serve in old age homes and retrieve reports for the same by the manager in charge.

#### **Hostel Facilities**

- The university has separate air-conditioned hostels for boys and girls.
- The hostel has its own cafeteria that serves all meals.
- ➤ The hostel has 24x7 Wi-Fi facility.
- > On line laundry facility within hostel.
- ➤ Hostel has indoor and outdoor games.
- ➤ Hostel students have library access post university hours as well.
- ➤ Hostel has a three-tier strong security system, enabled through CCTV cameras, and security staff at all time.

### IT INFRASTRUCTURE

KR Mangalam University has well developed IT facilities including Wi-Fi. Adequate number of computers with printers, scanners and high-speed internet are available in office, examination section, computer room, store and library. This includes extensive computer provision with all the computers in LAN with Internet facility. KRMU has focused consistently deployed best-in-class IT infrastructure and Applications development for Academic and Research support. Over 500+ LAN points are augmented across the campus computer labs and office spaces. The campus backbone network is of 120 Mbps, and Wi-Fi Network points over 75 numbers were deployed across the campus in all academic blocks and hostels blocks for 24X7 internet service, enabling students and faculty to stay connected and access the academic content, anywhere and everywhere in the campus. A Cloud Online Data centre is built to manage network operations efficiently and host all the servers with a continuous power supply so that the network and servers are monitored and are available for better connectivity across all teaching blocks. Server infrastructure includes high power computing nodes, IBM Rack Server with Cloud Base Storage. The enterprise Firewall CISCO has been deployed for handling enhanced load on network and applications, catering to academic and administrative processes, thereby providing a secure campus network. Additional ICT tools such as ZOOM and MS Teams for connecting online with students, faculty members, foreign universities and various other institutions in the country, have also been deployed. Microsoft Outlook, in a hosted environment, is provided to ensure email service for students, faculty and staff, to manage all the communication. Over 2000 Online Outlook mailboxes are hosted in the email solution. 350 desktops and 20 iMac are installed in computer labs, administrative offices and faculty work stations across the campus, giving computing facility to students and faculty for hands-on practical hands-on sessions. Business processes - Academic (Admissions, Academics to Examination), Back office (Fee collection, Hostel booking, Transport booking, with integrated online payment gateways, Staff recruitment, attendance and leaves management, payroll, etc) are done on UNISOFT.

All the students are provided access to Internet resources from various academic buildings and hostels on 24x7 basis. Students can login to their account for any kind of information and download from ERP and University's Website. The portal also caters to various needs of the researchers, faculty, Parents of the students and the staff of the University. With this system, learning and monitoring becomes easier and efficient. Most importantly, student-student and staff-student communication are greatly facilitated by this technology.

As our institution was established in 2013, we installed new systems in phases and augmented the IT infrastructure to establish new labs according to the requirements of new Schools. University has a policy to procure IT equipment and software as and when requirement raised by various Schools.


15 student toppers with more than 8.5 CGPA in their respective streams were bestowed with Gold Medals.


**Legal Aid Society**
