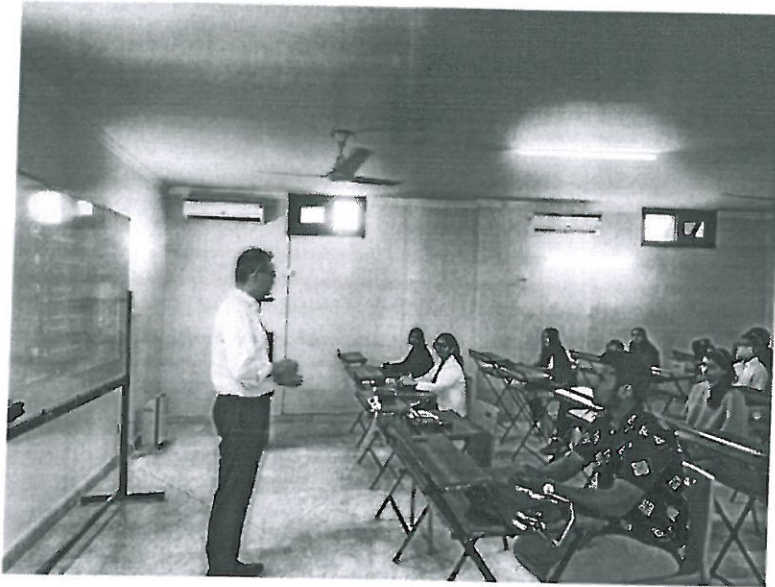

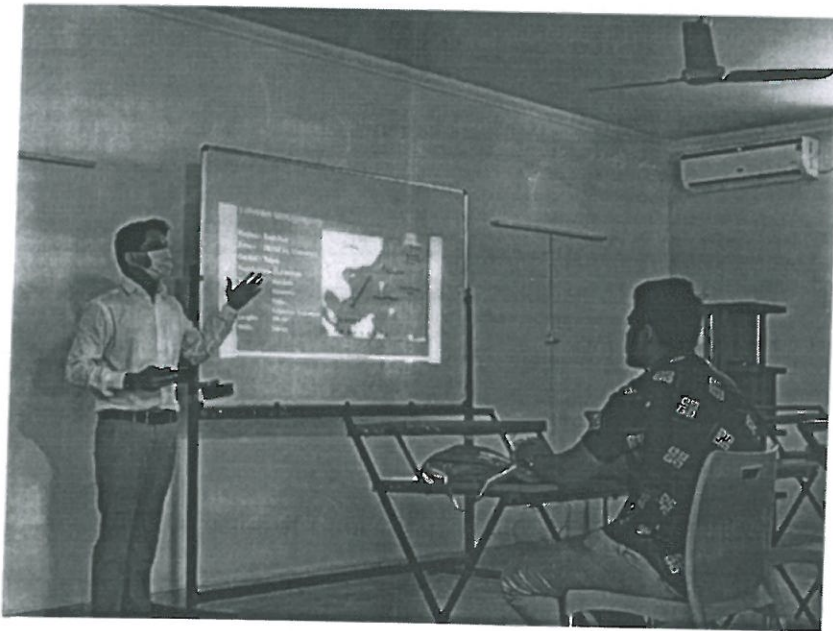

Details of TECC:

Taipei Economic and Cultural Center in India (TECC) is the Republic of China (Taiwan) government representative office in India. It is responsible for promoting ROC (Taiwan) and India's bilateral relations in the areas of the economy, trade, investment, the media, tourism, culture, education, science, and technology.

TECC has several divisions including Consular Division, Economic Division, Education Division, and Science and Technology Division. Each division is responsible for managing related aspects of the bilateral relationship and advancing mutual interests between Taiwan and South Asian countries including India, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Bhutan, and Nepal.

The Consular Division is responsible for the issuance of visas to foreigners who wish to travel to Taiwan and provides documents authentication services.

The Economic Division promotes economic and trade relations between Taiwan and aforesaid South Asian nations by engaging with the government authorities and private sectors.

The Education Division promotes educational communication with India, Bangladesh, Bhutan, and Nepal. Taiwan has constantly provided scholarships for students from South Asia and promoted higher education exchanges including Taiwan Fellowship for the scholars in the region through which there is swift flow of knowledge across national borders.

The Science and Technology Division aims to boost bilateral and multilateral scientific exchanges and activities. This Division is also actively promoting and bridging the cooperation amongst scientists, academics, and universities of Taiwan and those in India, Bangladesh, Bhutan, and Nepal.



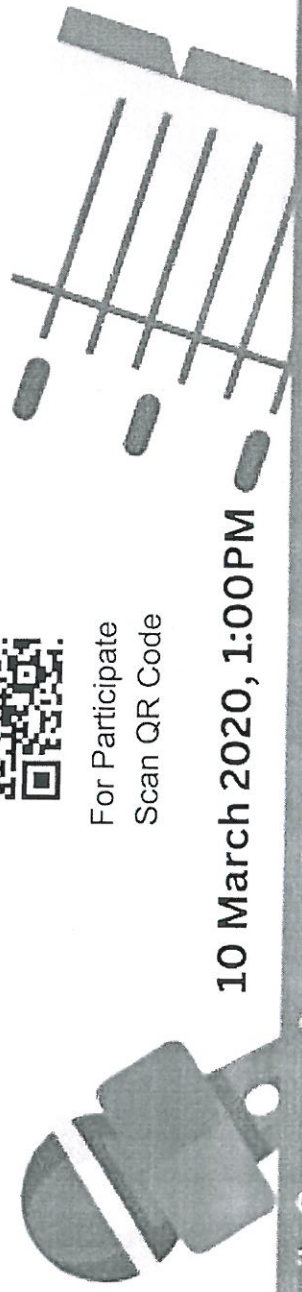

In an enthralling one and a half-hour session, Mr. Anton Anisimov (Photo-2) had touched upon many important facets about the '**Responsibility of Journalists - covering Military Conflicts**' and had put across his perspective on the war-torn Russia and Ukraine and how to understand the underpinning propaganda, cyber war and gatekeeping process by various stakeholders for their vested interests and motives beyond the ethics and responsibility of journalist and media person per se.

He said that "We don't have any issue with Ukraine as such, they are our brothers, and we are fighting to combat the Nazis only in Ukraine and looking forward to a peaceful early resolution". In this context, Ms Olga had highlighted the recent debate on the usages of indecent language in an India TV Show on "Times Now", on Russo-Ukraine War.


In concluding session, the experts had responded to the multiple questions posed by the students of Journalism and Mass Communication on the changing landscape of media, ethics, and war and its contour worldwide.

The session ended with a vote of thanks by the moderator Ms Olga Dycheva particularly she had acknowledged Prof (Dr) Kiran Bala, Dean, School of Journalism and Mass Communication, KRMU, Dr. Sarina and the students and faculties who attended the online session.

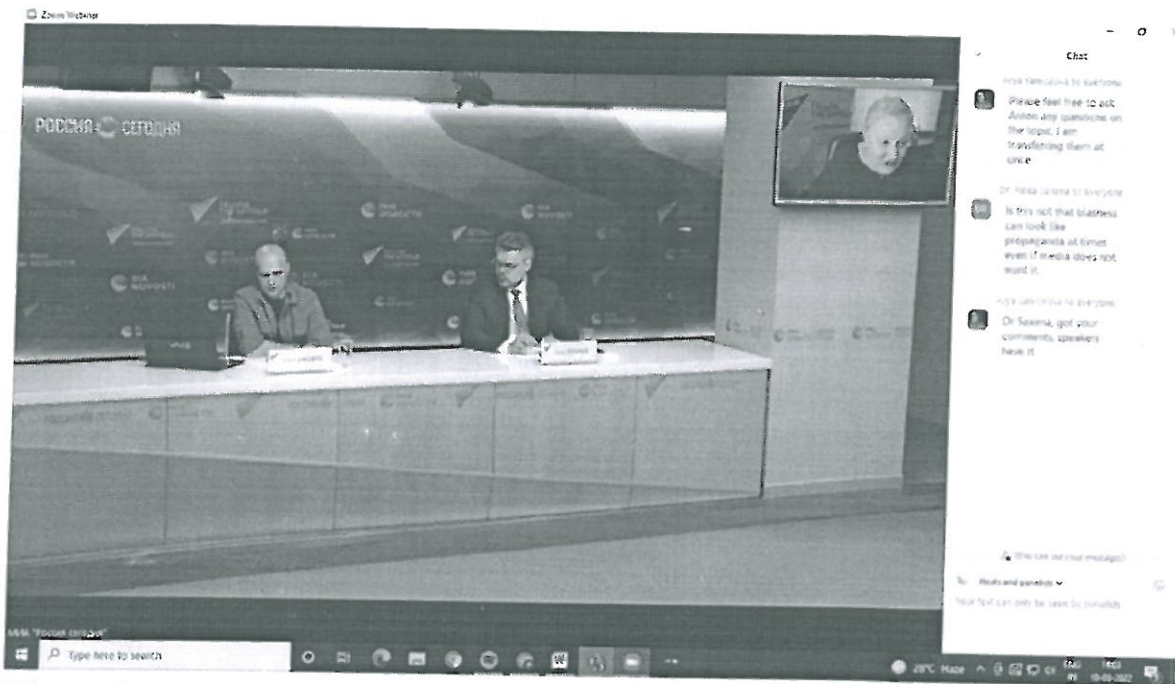

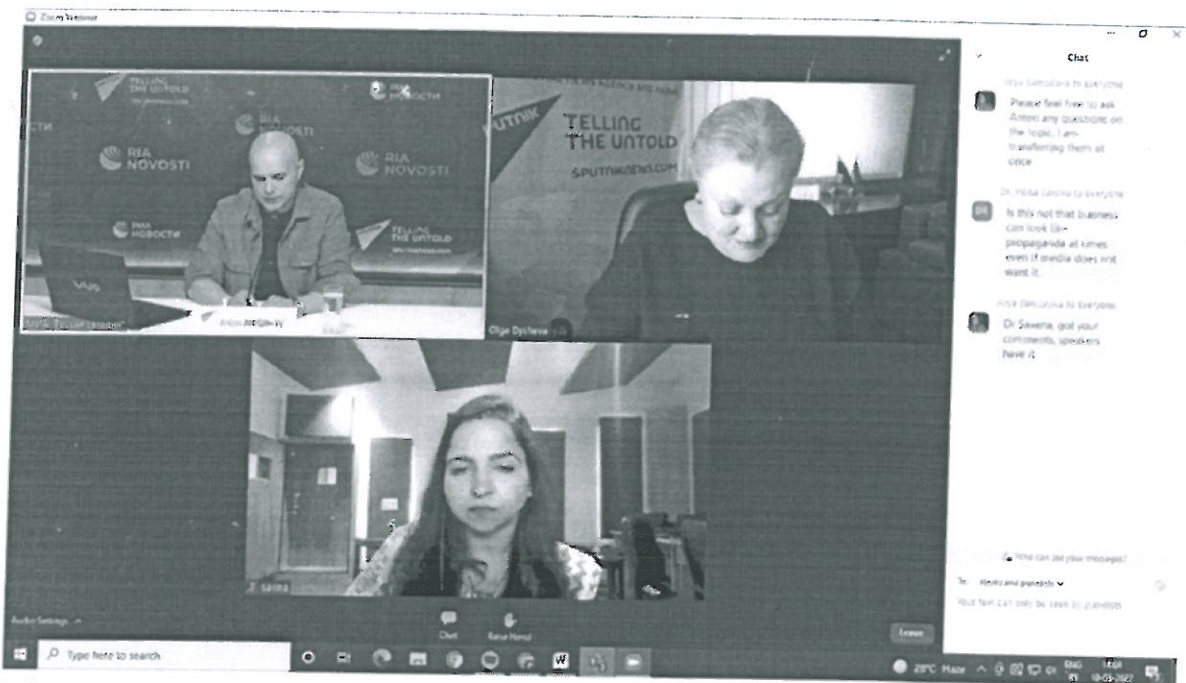

Conclusion

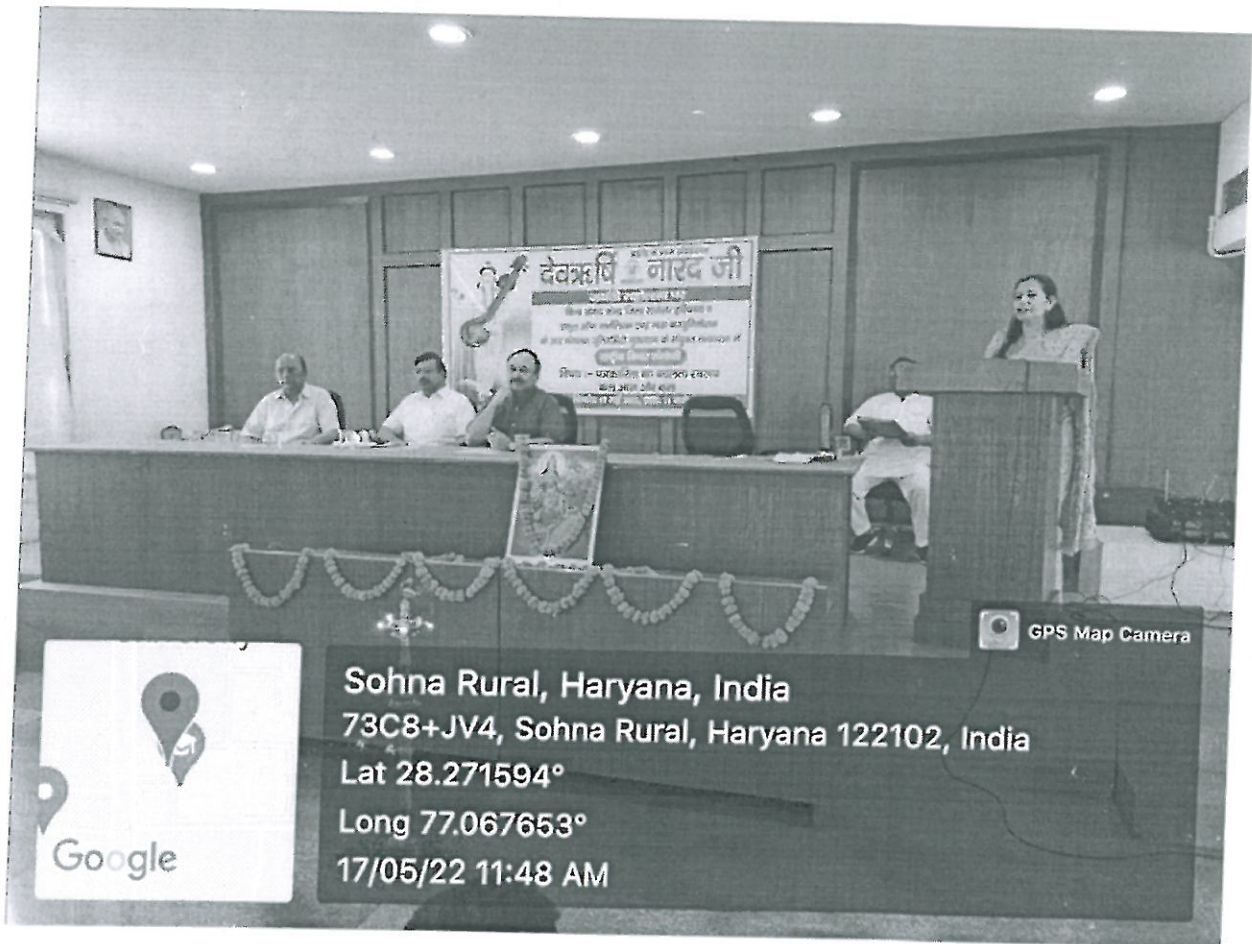

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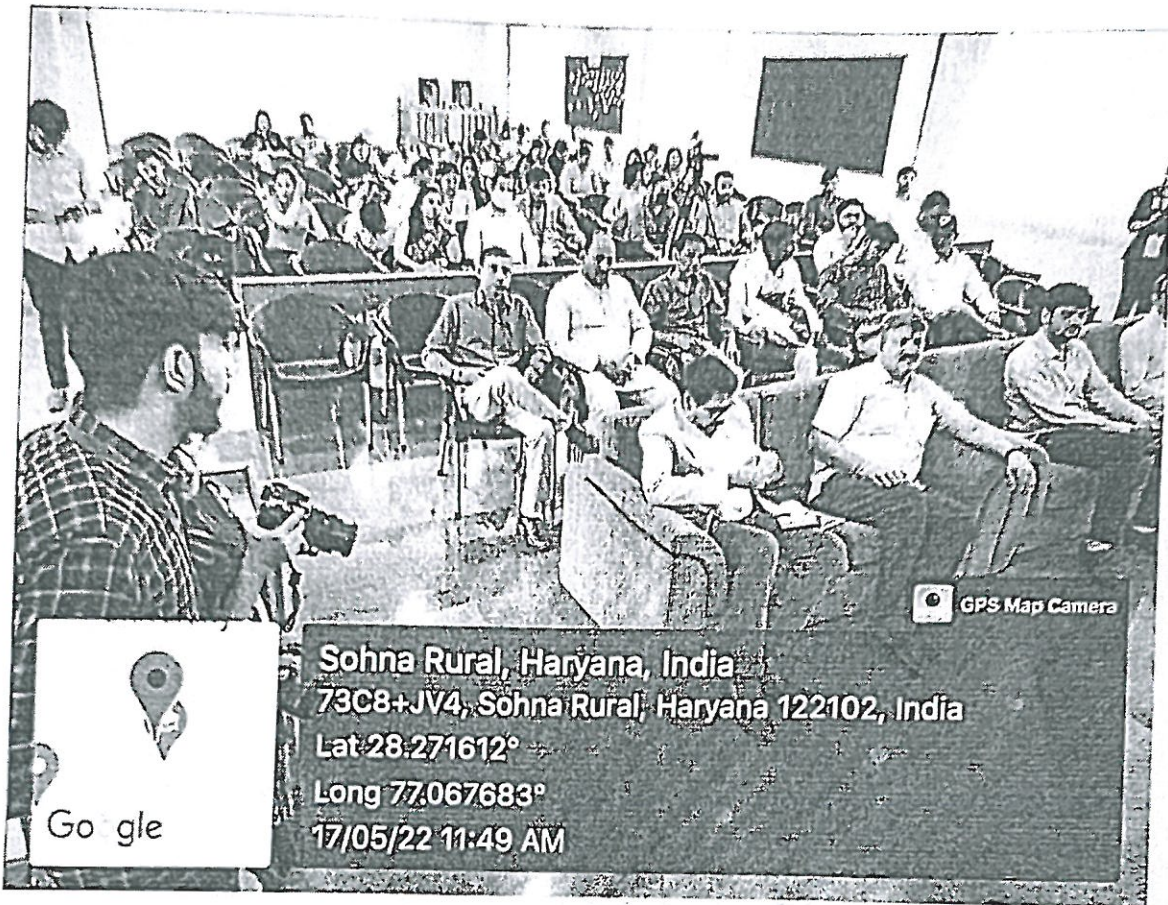


Photo 2: Faculty, Guests and Students pursuing Journalism and Mass Communication.

Further Scope :

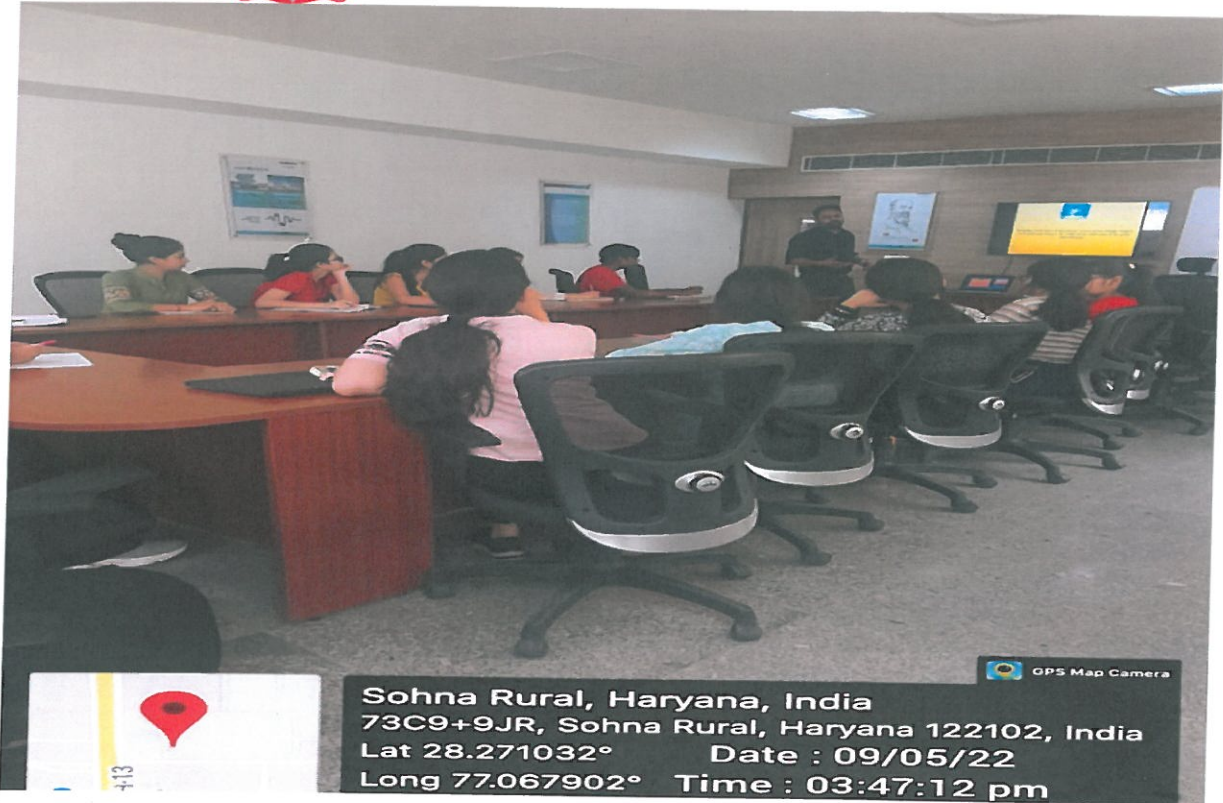

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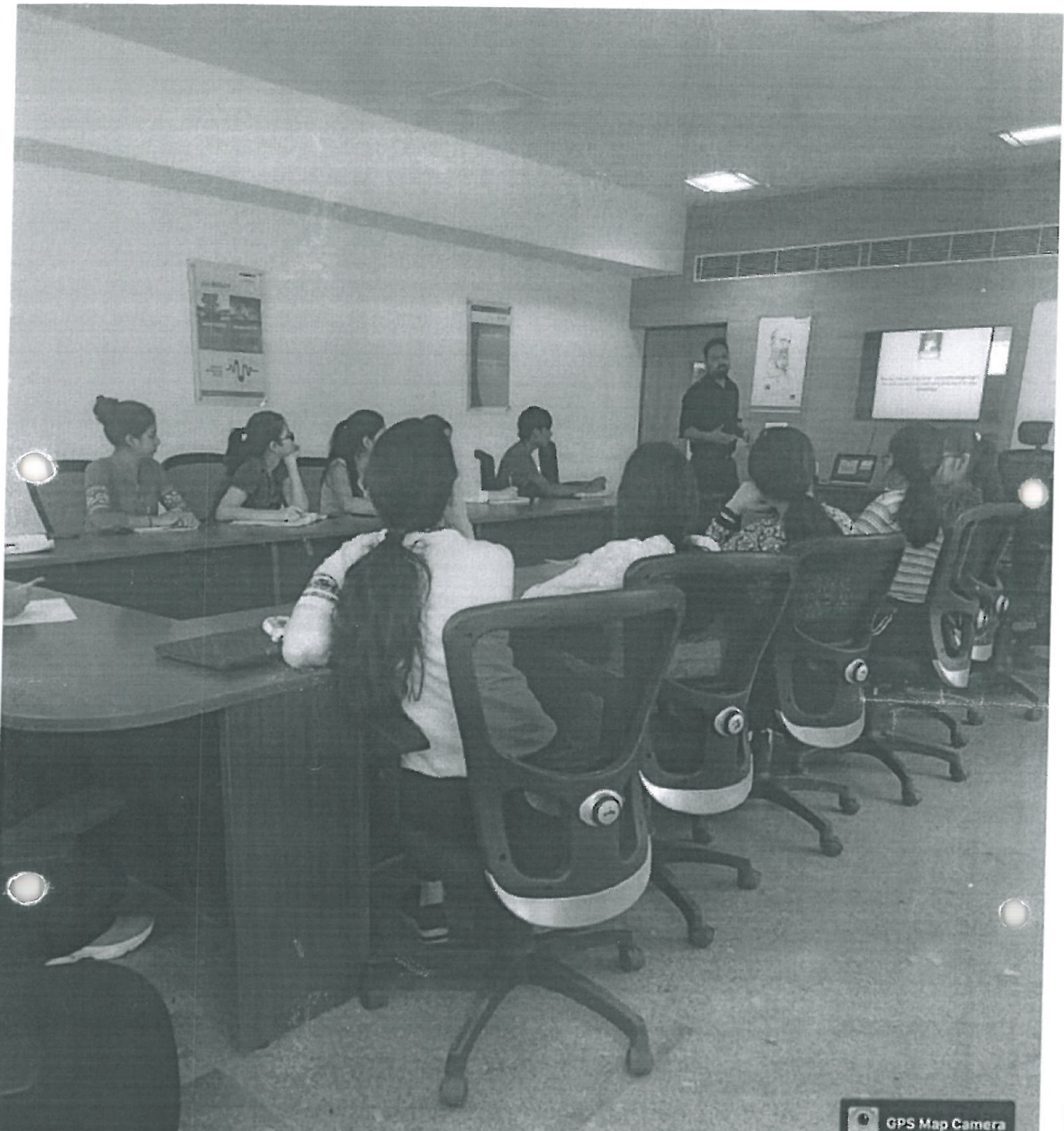
