The DIA Club organized a heritage walk to Badshahpur fort located in Gurgaon with the faculty in charge, Ar. Akanksha and Ar. Nishant. The Badshahpur fort is a very old fort, probably built during medieval periods exists at Badshahpur, a village in district Gurgaon. The aim of this visit was to explore and appreciate the heritage value of Badshahpur fort which dates to medieval times.

The fort has a significant historical and cultural significance, and it is one of the few remaining landmarks of its time. The students discerned that the unprotected fort is in ruins and needs restoration. The walls of the fort are high and thick, with several bastions and watchtowers at regular intervals. Only the walls and the watchtowers are intact. The fort is not maintained well, and there is no proper infrastructure to support tourism. The lake deposited beside the fort is surrounded by the lush green trees and has a serene ambiance. However, the fort still attracts a few visitors who are interested in history and archaeology.




Fig. 2 Students inside the fort.




Fig.2: Students working on poster.




Fig.3: Posters by students.
















Photo 2 (02/03/2023): Distribution of certificates among winners.


















Photo 1: Types of folding techniques




Photo 2: Experts showing different folding techniques




Photo 3: Lecture and Interaction session in room no. C208










Photo 1: Students working on Collage making activity.




Photo 2: Students arranging material for the Collage on Trends in Design.



#### Conclusion




## **Objectives**

### Introduction


