


On the 30th of May, a group of 12 students from KR Mangalam University along with the faculty coordinator. All of our students participated in the rap Competition.










Photo5: Audience of Framed: Photo Story Competition




Photo7: Anchor of Framed: Photo Story Competition




Photo 1: Student performing in Rap star Competition, Venue: Main Stage.




Photo 3: Student performing on "To Rap is to bring to the surface all the depth of one's being" in Rap star Competition, Venue: Main Stage.








Photo4: Competitor of Fusion dance competition










Photo 3: A group photograph with judges, organizers and wines of the event.
















Photo 1: Judges and Audience during the singing competition (23/11/2022)




Photo 1: Judges and Audience during the singing competition (23/11/2022)




Photo 2: Deepak Salim singing Carnatic (23/11/2022)






Photo 2: Distribution of Certificates to the winners






Photo.3: Students Performing act on drug abuse








