

## Silly vs Sane- Boggle the Brain

This is an Impromptu competition where participants will be randomly paired in two for the first two rounds and will be defending a given topic. The topics will be revealed 10 minutes prior to the competition. The competition will have three stages named *Fierce, Fiercer and Fiercest*.

### Guidelines for the competition

- Each team will be given **5-6 minutes** to perform.
- The participants should adhere to the **structure** of the competition as provided.
- On the spot topics will be given, and groups will be randomly allocated.
- The participants should be careful about **not to use offensive or derogatory remarks**.
- The participants can choose either **Hindi or English** for their performance.
- The judgment criteria will be **Diction, Fluency, Confidence, Clarity, Research and rebuttal with cross arguments**.
- The participants must switch on their cameras while speaking.

### How the event will proceed:

- Registration will be limited to maximum 20 participants. It will close 2 days prior to the final event (28th of September 2020).
- Participants will be a part of a WhatsApp group where all information will be shared.
- Structure of the event, groups, links and topics will be shared in the same group.
- At 9:30 am on 30th of September 2020, groups will be allocated.
- At 10 am group 1 will get their topic, group 2 will get it at 10:15 am, group 3 at 10:30 am and so on...

- The event will start at 10:30 am wherein each group will get 5 minutes to defend their topic.
- **Round 1** will end (in case of 10 groups\*) after 50 minutes. i.e., till 11:20 am max.
- Volunteers will mute the participants if they exceed the given time limit.
- Judges will announce results of **Round 1** till 11:35am.
- **Round 2** will start at 11:45 am where each group will get 5 minutes to defend their topic.
- **Round 2** will end (with 5 groups) after 25 minutes, i.e., at 12:10 pm.
- Judges will announce the results of **Round 2** by 12:20 pm.
- **Round 3** will start at 12:30 pm (so 5 people will discuss the topic given on the spot.) each person will be given 2 minutes to speak.
- Winner will be selected by the judges and two best speakers will be considered for 1st and 2nd position.
- The event will conclude at 1pm.
