## Executive Summary

The Employment Survey for Academic Year 2024-25 was conducted by K.R. Mangalam University to systematically assess the employment outcomes and career progression of graduating students. This comprehensive report presents findings from 761 responses received from graduates across 12 schools, providing critical insights into placement trends, salary distributions, and industry engagement.


The survey reveals robust placement performance across all academic schools, with particularly strong outcomes in engineering, management, and humanities disciplines. This report serves as a crucial tool for quality assurance, curriculum enhancement, and strategic planning, aligning with NAAC and NEP 2020 frameworks.


## Salary Distribution and Trends



- 569 students successfully placed out of 761 responses received
- Average package of ₹5.27 LPA, competitive within the sector
- 178 students pursuing higher education, demonstrating academic excellence

### 2. Balanced School-wise Distribution

- All schools demonstrated successful placement outcomes
- Engineering, Management, Architecture, Pharmacy, Sciences and Humanities led in absolute numbers
- Specialized schools showed focused sectoral placements

### 3. Competitive Salary Distribution

- 38% of placements in the ₹3-5 LPA range
- 31% of placements above ₹5 LPA, demonstrating quality placements
- Highest package of ₹38 LPA demonstrates top-tier placement capability

- Increase structured industry visits and company interactions
- Expand internship partnerships with leading organizations
- Develop industry mentorship programs pairing students with professionals

### 2. Strengthen Skill Development

- Provide certification programs aligned with industry requirements

### 3. Expand Employer Base

- Target emerging sectors and startups for recruitment
- Develop international placement opportunities
- Strengthen alumni network for placement referrals
